In the context of resettlement, the Republic of Croatia for the first time began to actively participate in the resettlement program in 2017 based on the Decision on relocation and resettlement of third-country nationals or stateless persons who are eligible for international protection (Official Gazette 78/15). Up to now, 152 people have been resettled.

- 1. The first group of resettled persons arrived in Bulgaria in June 2018. Up to now 21 people have been resettled.
- 2. One person out of 21 is vulnerable.
- 3. Communication with both literate and illiterate people is done with the help of an interpreter. Upon arrival, the persons start Bulgarian language training.
